

## HOW TO REACH TREGOOSE

### From Exeter and the East

Just past Exeter, we recommend that you take the A30 via Okehampton, though you can go straight on through Plymouth. You will bypass Okehampton, Launceston and Bodmin and about 7 miles after Bodmin, pass the Newquay exit. Continue past that exit, over the top of Highgate Hill and take the next exit about half way down the other side, signed, amongst other places, Grampound Road. A McDonald's sign is visible on the right hand side of the dual carriageway. Follow the signs to Grampound Road, going straight over a crossroads in the process, for about 4 miles. Go through Grampound Road, and after about half a mile, you will come to another crossroads. This is the A390 Liskeard to Truro road. Turn right towards Truro and you will see *immediately*, on the right hand side, the back of large roadsign and four black and white reflector posts just where the central double white lines end. Turn between these posts into a sunken lane. The house is 300 yards down this lane, straight through white gates.

### From West Cornwall

Take the A30 towards Bodmin. At Chyverton Roundabout just west of Truro, turn off onto the A390 to Truro. Follow this road round the Truro Bypass, now following signs to St Austell. Having left Truro the road passes through Tresillian village and some 6 miles after Truro comes to Trewithen Roundabout. Again following signs for St Austell continue on the A390 for half a mile, passing the white railings at the entrance to Trewithen Gardens on the right, and a Speed Cameras sign on the left. 100 yards further on, the lane to Tregoose is on the left hand side immediately before the large, green roadsign marking the Grampound Road/St Mawes junction. There are four black and white reflector posts on the left just where the central double white lines begin. Turn between these posts into a sunken lane. The house is 300 yards down this lane, straight through white gates.

### From Newquay Airport

Turn right out of the airport carpark and follow the road along to the A3059. Turn left towards Truro and St Austell. After about a mile there is a roundabout at the junction with the A39. Take the Truro exit. At the next roundabout (called Halloon) take the second exit, signed A30, Bodmin, Redruth. After 500 yards, there is another roundabout at the A30 junction. Take the exit signed Truro, Redruth. Join the A30 for half a mile and go up over the crest of Highgate Hill. About half way down the other side, take the exit left, signed, amongst other places, Grampound Road. A McDonald's sign is visible on the right hand side of the dual carriageway. Follow the signs to Grampound Road, going straight over a crossroads in the process, for about 4 miles. Go through Grampound Road, and after about half a mile, you will come to another crossroads. This is the A390 Liskeard to Truro road. Turn right towards Truro and you will see immediately, on the right hand side, the back of large roadsign and four black and white reflector posts just where the central double white lines end.
